Guidelines for Extracurricular Ticket Sales

FOOTBALL

The 10-AAA DEC reviewed the UIL guidelines regarding spectator seating. The DEC determined that we would sell tickets based on 50% occupancy, defined by 50% of any seating / standing area designated by the home stadium. This could include bleacher seating areas, standing or sitting areas along fence lines and seating on the track for various staff or student groups (band, cheer, drill, etc.)

The DEC voted that bands will not travel to away games because of the seating capacity limitations. The committee voted to postpone all district passes for the season. Reserved Section Season tickets and Golden Passes will also be postponed for this season.

VARSITY

Ticket Sales:

Home:

Each football player on the Varsity Team will be offered four tickets for purchase. Varsity Cheerleaders and Band members will also be offered four tickets. To be guaranteed tickets, students must purchase tickets from the high school office no later than 3:30 pm on August 21st for pre-season games and no later than 3:30pm on September 25th for in-district games.

If you prefer to purchase weekly, that accommodation can be made through the HS office.

All staff members will get one free ticket for home games.

ALL OTHER REMAINING HOME GAME TICKETS WILL BE SOLD AT THE GATE.

Away:

- ❖ All "Visitor" tickets will be pre-sold. The process depends on the district. Some districts are choosing to use an online ticketing system.

- ❖ No Passes will be honored.
- ❖ A set # of tickets will be determined for each site based on 50% capacity at each stadium.
- ❖ Pewitt's process:
 - Pewitt CISD will sell "away" paper tickets in the order below. Each week we will notify staff, students, and the community by social media of how the "away" game tickets will be sold for that week.
 - 1. Ticket sales for student participant families
 - Each Varsity Football Player traveling with the team and Varsity Cheerleaders will be offered four tickets that must be purchased no later than 3:30 pm on August 21st for pre-season games and no later than 3:30pm on September 25th for in-district games. All tickets are \$5.
 - 2. Ticket sales for staff members
 - If there are available tickets, staff members will be given the option to purchase two tickets.
 - Tickets for staff members will be available on Tuesday of the week of the game at 6:30 a.m. at the Pewitt Alumni Center.
 - 3. Ticket sales to High School students
 - If there are available tickets, HS students may purchase one ticket from the HS office during lunch.
 - Tickets for students will be available on Wednesday of the week of the game.
 - 4. Ticket sales to community members and other fans
 - If there are available tickets, fans may purchase up to four tickets per person purchasing the tickets.
 - Tickets for fans/community members may be purchased at the administration office on Thursday of the week of the game at 6:30 a.m. Remaining tickets are sold until they are gone.

Please note: Some schools will use an online ticketing system and paper tickets will not be used besides the presale family tickets.

Home: There will be no pre-sale tickets. All tickets will be sold at the gate.

Away: There will be no pre-sale tickets. All tickets will be sold at the gate.

FACE COVERINGS

- ❖ **Per UIL guidelines, all fans, spectators, athletes, etc. will be required to wear a face covering upon entering the stadium.** Athletes are required to wear a face covering at all times unless they are competing.

SCREENING

- ❖ Each stadium will have a sign that notes that people can only enter if they are symptom free and have not been exposed.

SOCIAL DISTANCING

- ❖ All fans, spectators, teams, etc are requested to maintain 6' distancing between household groups while in the building.

VOLLEYBALL (these guidelines were developed by a separate DEC and may vary slightly)

The 14-AAA District Executive Committee met to discuss the UIL guidelines for fall sports competition. The committee voted to postpone all district passes for the season. District Passes and Golden Passes will also be postponed for this season.

It is the goal of the DEC to maximize the opportunities for our students to engage in competition while also following UIL guidelines in providing for the health and safety of athletes, staff and fans. These guidelines are subject to change as guidance from health officials or UIL change. We appreciate the support of parents and fans in helping us this fall.

Gym Capacity

Per UIL guidelines, gyms will be capped at 50% capacity. Each school has determined 50% capacity of the visitor's section and 50% capacity of their home section.

Tickets- Pewitt Process

All tickets will be sold at the door. We will not pre-sale tickets for volleyball. All tickets will be \$3 for in-district games.

Away:

Tickets will either be sold at the door or using an online ticketing system. We will give information as we are informed by the opposing district. All tickets will be \$3 for in-district games.

Face Coverings

Per UIL guidelines, all fans, spectators, athletes, etc will be required to wear a face covering upon entering the building and in the stands when social distancing is not possible. Athletes are required to wear a face covering at all times unless they are competing.

Screening

Each stadium will have a sign that notes that people can only enter if they are symptom free and have not been exposed.

Social Distancing

All fans, spectators, teams, etc. are requested to maintain 6' distancing between household groups while in the building.
