

Dyslexia Report for School Year 2018-2019

Act 1039 of 2017 Reporting by the School District (A.C.A. § 6-41-606 (b))

Dyslexia Program:

During the 2018-2019 school year, Alpena Public School District used the evidence-based Wilson Foundations Program and the Wilson Reading System Program in small group intervention to address the deficit areas of students identified as exhibiting the characteristics of dyslexia.

Number of Students Who Received Dyslexia Intervention:

During the 2018-2019 school year, 17 Kindergarten-6th grade students and 7 Jr. High/High School students attending the Alpena Public School District received dyslexia intervention services from a trained dyslexia interventionist.

Total Number of Students Identified as Exhibiting the Characteristics of Dyslexia:

During the 2018-2019 school year, 30 students attending Alpena Public School District were identified as exhibiting the characteristics of dyslexia. This total includes those students who received dyslexia intervention (24) and those whose parents chose to opt-out of the offered characteristics of dyslexia services (6).
