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Goal 1: During this school year, LISD district staff will develop and implement an academic system to support our diverse population.

Performance Objective 1: STAAR assessment Approaches Grade Level performance will be at least 65% in all subgroups and 75% for all students in each content area. NWEA will be at or above 75% when totaling Average, HiAverage, and Hi.

Performance Objective 2: The percentage of "all student" performance in ELAR will increase by 5% annually to achievement levels of 75% Approaches Grade Level, 40% Meets Grade Level and 20% Masters Grade Level by May 2018. ESSA, 17-18

Performance Objective 3: Reading and Math student growth measured by NWEA and STAAR will be at least 65% for Expected and 20% for exceeded in each grade level.

Performance Objective 4: STAAR Meets Grade Level performance will be 40%. Graduation Rate and Graduation Plan will be greater than 90% and Postsecondary Readiness CTE will exceed 95%. NWEA HiAvg and Hi total will be greater than 60% based on the NWEA grade level report.

Performance Objective 5: All grade and content Masters Grade Level scores will increase by 2% each year until the scores are at least 20%. NWEA Hi performance will increase by 2% each year until the scores are at least 20%.

Performance Objective 6: MIGRANT PFS ACTION PLAN: Ensure Priority for Services students are being served first and foremost and are receiving the appropriate individualized services to address their academic needs.

Goal 2: LISD will utilize technology to enhance instruction and manage relevant data, in addition to linking the district to the home and community.

Performance Objective 1: Teachers and students will be provided opportunities to grow their technology skills.
