**BOARD OF TRUSTEES**  
**SUMMARY OF BOARD MEETING**  
**January 8, 2018**

The Shelbyville I.S.D. Board of Trustees met in regular session on Monday, January 8, 2018, at 6:00 p.m. in the Board Room, Shelbyville I.S.D. Board members present were Etola Jones, Joe Tom Schillings, Joey Lawson, Mark Bohannon, Tim Bradshaw, Chris Koltonski, and Duane Lout.

The meeting was called to order, and the invocation was given. The Board then recited the pledge to the American flag.

There were no open forum communications.

The Board reviewed the minutes from the meeting of December 11, 2017. The Board also reviewed the financial reports. The minutes and financial reports were unanimously approved as presented.

January is School Board Recognition Month, proclaimed to build awareness and understanding of the crucial function an elected Board of Trustees plays in our schools and communities. Elementary principal Mike Furlow introduced Gracie Miller and Jayleigh Jones to the board. They presented each board member with a poster made by each grade and a gift from the elementary campus. PK students also made each board member a placemat for the appreciation dinner following the board meeting. Middle school principal Thomas Swearngen presented each board member with a gift from the middle school campus. From the high school campus, Principal Mario Osby introduced Kyle Tindol and Logan Jefferson, who presented a plaque and a gift to each board member.

Senior students Kyle Tindol and Logan Jefferson then addressed the Board and asked for approval for a senior trip to Kemah, Texas, on May 13-15. The Board voted unanimously to approve the senior trip.

Lizbeth Bautista and Yadira Reyes, members of the Shelbyville Marching Band, then addressed the Board and asked for approval of a band trip to Memphis, Tennessee, on May 19-22. The band will perform at Graceland. The Board voted unanimously to approve the band trip.

In Principal's Reports, Mike Furlow addressed the Board concerning the elementary campus. We placed 2<sup>nd</sup> at the elementary UIL district meet held last month. The elementary awards program was held January 5<sup>th</sup>. The UIL reward skating and pizza party will be held tomorrow. The Extended Day program begins February 6<sup>th</sup>. Current enrollment is 395.

Middle school principal Thomas Swearngen addressed the Board concerning events on his campus. The middle school UIL reward skating and pizza party was held today. Benchmarks will be given on his campus all week. The Extended Day program begins February 6<sup>th</sup> and ends on April 26<sup>th</sup>.

High school principal Mario Osby addressed the Board about his campus. There is an academic UIL practice meet in Chireno this weekend. UIL participants will also compete at a practice meet in Whitehouse next weekend. Benchmarks will be given tomorrow. Baseball, softball, and track will begin soon.

Dr. West gave the following Superintendent's Reports: (1) There was a minor bus accident this afternoon. Our bus was not at fault, and thankfully, no one was injured. (2) The Board was given copies of articles of interest.

The Board convened a closed meeting at 6:19 p.m. under the Texas Government Code, Section 551. The Board reconvened an open session at 6:56 p.m. The Board voted unanimously to accept the resignation of Charles Tindol as athletic director. The Board voted unanimously to approve a maternity leave of absence for Lindsay Davis.
