BOARD OF TRUSTEES
SUMMARY OF BOARD MEETING
April 8, 2019

The Shelbyville I.S.D. Board of Trustees met in regular session on Monday, April 8, 2019, at 6:00 p.m. in the Board Room, Shelbyville I.S.D. Board members present were Etola Jones, Chris Koltonski, Joey Lawson, Joe Tom Schillings, Duane Lout, Tim Bradshaw, and Mark Bohannon.

The meeting was called to order, and the invocation was given. The Board then recited the pledge to the American flag.

There were no open forum communications.

The Board reviewed the minutes from the meeting of March 5, 2019. The Board also reviewed the financial reports. The minutes and financial reports were unanimously approved as presented.

The Board considered changing the May board meeting date and time from Monday, May 13th, to Tuesday, May 7th, at noon. The Board voted unanimously to change the board meeting date and time.

The Board considered student athletic insurance for 2019-20. Dr. West recommended that we again accept the bid from Texas Kids First for a cost of \$10,660.88, and the Board voted unanimously to accept the recommended proposal for athletic insurance.

Dr. West asked to table action on the 2019-20 school calendar.

The Board considered renewing the district's contract with Statewide Educational Consulting and Counseling Associates, Inc. SECCA assists us with federal grant applications and our state compensatory program. The Board voted unanimously to approve contracts with SECCA as presented.

The Board next considered textbook adoptions (Instructional Materials Allotment) for the 2019-20 school year. Textbook custodian Thomas Swearngen recommended that all titles on the state adopted list be adopted, and the Board voted unanimously to accept Mr. Swearngen's recommendation.

The Board considered budget amendments for 2018-19. Thee Board voted unanimously to approve the amendments as presented.

In Principal's Reports, Mike Furlow addressed the Board concerning the elementary campus. Addison Sowell received a G/T scholarship from LeTourneau University. STAAR tests

will be given this week. Spring pictures will be taken on April 17th. Elementary field day will be held May 3rd. The elementary teacher appreciation lunch will be held on May 9th. Special Olympics will be held here on April 24th. The elementary teacher of the year is Jason McDonald.

Middle school principal Thomas Swearingen addressed the Board concerning events on his campus. STAAR tests will be given this week. The middle school teacher of the year is Bailee Rash.

High school principal Mario Osby addressed the Board about his campus. Our boys' basketball team is the 2A state champion! We also won the district academic UIL meet. The district track meet will be held here this week. End of course exams will be given tomorrow. We have ag students that will compete at the area round of contests. High school teacher of the year is Brooke Harrison.

Dr. West gave the following Superintendent's Reports: (1) TASB's school board spring workshop will be held on May 14th at SFA. (2) Our high school boys' basketball team culminated a terrific season by winning the 2A State Championship in San Antonio. Jay Buckley was named MVP for the championship game. He, Jordan Boykins, and Cole Ferguson were named to the All-Tournament team. We are once again district champions for academic UIL. We won by more than 120 points. Our students who placed 1st, 2nd, or 3rd will compete at the regional meet this week. Our girls' powerlifting team competed at the state meet in Waco. Jaiden Rose placed 3rd, Diana Valencia finished 6th, and Jada Moore finished 10th. (3) The Board was given copies of articles of interest.

President Etola Jones presented Duane Lout a plaque thanking him for his dedication and service to the school. Mr. Lout served seven years on the Board and chose not to seek reelection. Dr. West and other board members expressed their gratitude and appreciation to Mr. Lout.

The Board convened a closed meeting at 6:40 p.m. in accordance with the Texas Open Meetings Act, Texas Government Code, Chapter 551. The Board reconvened an open session at 7:32 p.m.
