

Crockett Area Chamber of Commerce Scholarship Program 2021/2022

The Crockett Area Chamber of Commerce is proud to announce it will be giving away an Educational Scholarship for the 2021/2022 school year. The recipient will be selected in May of 2022. Students and counselors need to be aware of both the academic and volunteer requirements of the scholarship. Please find attached a copy of the scholarship application.

It is imperative that any student interested in applying for this scholarship be aware of the Chamber of Commerce Volunteer Service hours that are required. The applicant must have had a minimum of 12 hours of volunteer work directly with the Crockett Area Chamber of Commerce. Other community volunteer work, while very worthy, is not allowed to be transferred over for use for this scholarship. The hours must come from volunteering and helping directly with Chamber of Commerce Events.

Christmas in Crockett will be held on Saturday, November 20th. This will be the Chamber's first large event of the school year that will give students an excellent opportunity to accumulate hours.

PLEASE HAVE STUDENTS CONTACT THE CHAMBER OF COMMERCE AS SOON AS POSSIBLE to schedule their slots for volunteer hours.

Requirements:

- Must have a high school GPA of 3.0 or above (provide high school transcript).
- Applicant must plan to attend a school of higher education upon graduation.
- A personal interview may be requested.
- Verification of enrollment at the school of higher education (class schedule or fee statement) must be provided before the scholarship will be awarded. A minimum of 12 hours of enrollment must be maintained.
- Applicant is required to submit (2) two letter of recommendations, from teachers only.
- Applicant must prepare an essay of 300- 500 words or less on ONE of four topics offered in the Essay Section.
- Applicant must complete 12 hours of volunteer time with the Crockett Area Chamber of Commerce or acceptable events in the community involving the Crockett Area Chamber of Commerce. Applicants must provide a volunteer sheet with proof of 12 hours service, with appropriate signatures. (provided at beginning of volunteer time/school year)
