

Attendance Requirements for High School Credit Courses at the Middle School

For students taking high school courses while enrolled at Hudson Middle School, attendance is recorded for every class period. To earn high school credit in enrolled courses, they must meet the 90% attendance requirement.

Texas Education Code (TEC) Section 25.092, under attendance for course credit reads: "...conditions credit or a final grade for a class on a student's attendance for at least 90 percent of the days a class is offered."

High school credit courses offered at the middle school include: Algebra 1, Art 1, Art 2, Biology 1, Concepts of Engineering and Technology, Principles of Information Technology, Principles of Information Technology - Hydroponics.

Students attend class for high school credit daily, or every other day on the A/B day schedule. The following table explains the number of days missed per semester permissible.

Course schedule	Days in session	Absences permitted
Class meets daily	93	10
Class meets every other day (A/B days)	48	5
