STAGE 5

CONDITIONS

- COVID-19 vaccines are widely available for select ages of children and adults by medical providers
- COVID-19 virus is endemic in the United States

HUDSON ISD

- Face coverings are a personal choice
- No restrictions for visitors or school activities
- Parents/Staff notified of any test-confirmed cases in classroom, extracurricular, or other cohort groups.
- Monitor community health trends
- Maintain cleaning protocols

STAGE 4

CONDITIONS

- COVID-19 vaccines are widely available for select ages of children and adults by medical providers
- Campus absenteeism rate due to illness is greater than 10% of the historical rate
- COVID-19 active case rate is below 1% districtwide

HUDSON ISD

- Face coverings are recommended, but not required
- No restrictions for visitors or school activities
- Parents/Staff notified of any test-confirmed cases in classroom, extracurricular, or other cohort groups.
- Self-health daily monitoring recommended
- Maintain cleaning protocols
- Social distancing recommended

STAGE 3

CONDITIONS

- District absenteeism rate due to illness is greater than 10% of the historical rate
- COVID-19 community outbreak determined

HUDSON ISD

- Face coverings are highly recommended
- Increase mitigation strategies until attendance rate has increased by 5% for two weeks
- Buildings may close for deep cleaning
- Parents/Staff notified of any test-confirmed cases in classroom, extracurricular, or other cohort groups.
- Visitor access modified
- Extracurricular activities continue with additional protocols in place

Modified Operations



STAGE 2

CONDITIONS

- Local or state health authorities issue health orders which may impact school operations based on resurgence of COVID-19, variant, or another infectious virus

HUDSON ISD

- Implementation of required health mitigation strategies
- Parents/Staff notified of any test-confirmed cases in classroom, extracurricular, or other cohort groups.
- Evaluate and consider methods for instructional delivery
- Visitor access restricted
- Extracurricular activities may be restricted or canceled

District Closure



STAGE 1

CONDITIONS

- Governor, Texas Education Agency, or other health authority orders the closure of schools based on resurgence of COVID-19, variant, or another infectious virus

HUDSON ISD

- All students and staff follow guidance provided for instructional delivery
- All areas subject to school oversight closed to public (park area, playgrounds, and facilities)
- All other activities are cancelled
