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LCM High School April STAAR information:

LCM High School will administer the STAAR English I and II End-of-Course exams on April 6 (English I) and April 8 (English 2).

Students who are required to participate are:

- 1) Students who have previously taken but failed one or both of these STAAR exams
- 2) Students who took one of these courses in the 2019-20 school year but who did not receive full credit for the course (students who did not pass a STAAR tested class in 2019-20 did not receive the state waiver for STAAR)
- 3) Students who are currently enrolled in an English I or II class for the first time

On April 6 and 8, any students who are NOT required to participate in the STAAR English assessments, will attend class/complete assignments virtually through TEAMS instead of reporting to campus. Students must attend/complete posted assignments via TEAMS to be counted for attendance purposes. The exception to this will be if a campus teacher of a dual-enrolled college course wants to meet with his/her students on April 6 and 8 (these teachers will inform their students if they need to report to campus or not). **The virtual learning/attendance for students who are not involved in STAAR on April 6 and 8 only pertains to LCM High School students, not to students of other LCM campuses.**

Students who have been regularly attending school virtually are required to come to campus to take their STAAR exams, as the state has not issued any sort of waiver this year, nor do the state's STAAR graduation requirements change for virtual learners. A letter has been sent to regular virtual learners informing them of the date(s) they should report to the LCM High School campus for their STAAR exam(s).
