This is a reminder that the Little Cypress-Mauriceville School District has partnered with Texas Children's Hospital, and Baylor College of Medicine to provide a three-pronged tele-health service to LCM students, parents and staff. All of these services are confidential between the hospitals and the person being served.

For those who feel their child may need evaluations and medical management, call 832-822-3400 or complete an online form at <https://www.texaschildrens.org/refer/behavioral-and-developmental-services>. The first consultation will take place in a private setting at your child's school, with a parent in attendance.

*Project Gold* is another service offered by Texas Children's Hospital and provides the child the help of a licensed counselor due the traumatic after effects of Hurricane Harvey, bullying, or other childhood stressors. The third piece to this healthcare offering is *Project Heart*; counseling for parents, staff and community members 18 years and above. Sessions are conducted via wi-fi computer or phone at home and *does not necessitate a visit to any school campus*. The counselors for this program are with Baylor College of Medicine.
