

Drive in WiFi Now Available for Students and Staff

LCMCISD plans to have drive-up WiFi resources available from 8:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. each day. You can drive up and park in designated parking lots and maintain social distancing while using specific login credentials for an employee or student's account. You can use these services to post lessons or homework, submit assignments, etc.

To log on to the WiFi, connect to the LCMPARENT network from your device like you would attach to any other WiFi network. For example, your home network, Starbucks, public libraries, etc. Enter the password **COVID19BEAR\$** (case-sensitive, make sure you type in ALL CAPS)

After you have successfully connected to the LCMPARENT network, you will see an iBoss login page. You may have to click on a message that says "Sign into Network" for that page to come up. (Note: this may depend on the device you are using.) Enter the student or employee username and password used to login to computers/laptops when they were on campus and click done. **NOTE: YOU MUST HAVE YOUR EMPLOYEE OR STUDENT USERNAME AND PASSWORD TO GET INTERNET ACCESS.**

Drive-up WiFi access for LCM students and employees will be at the following locations:

At **LCMHS**: The parking lot at the front entrance of the school, the teacher parking lot on the North side of the school, and part of the student parking lot by the band hall.

At **LCJH**: The parking lot at the front entrance of the school on FM 1130.

At **MVE**: The parking lot at the front entrance of the school on FM 1130. (closer to the west-daycare side)

At **Technology**: The parking lot across the street from the Administration Building. The southern part of that building where the Special Programs department was located.

At **MMS**: The parking lot at the front entrance of the school on FM 1130.

The quality of this wireless network is not guaranteed as it all depends on where you park in relation to the access points and the number of users accessing the network at the same time.

The maps below will indicate the signal strength estimates.
