Announcement New Texas Children's Psychiatry Clinic Opening

Dear Families,

Texas Children's Hospital is pleased to announce a tele-health psychiatry clinic that is opening up in your school district.

This clinic gives families the expertise of our world-class physicians without the hassle of a lost school or work day to travel into Houston.

This clinic is independently operated by Texas Children's Hospital, but we are happy to partner with your school district for the confidential space to expertly assess and treat, if clinically indicated, emotional and behavioral disorders under the auspices of the Re-Build Texas Grant helping families post Hurricane Harvey. Our team appreciates that many are still suffering the after effects of this devastating storm and some may have had emotional health concerns even prior to Hurricane Harvey.

Our clinic sees patients starting at age 4 and goes up to 18 (or older if the patient is still enrolled in school). We can assess and treat a variety of condition: Attentional problems, Anxiety, Depression, Severe behavior or Mood issues, Autism, Trauma as a result of the Hurricane or *other life* events. We do not assess for learning disorders, and would recommend you coordinate with your ISD if learning differences are a concern.

Appointments are confidential and separate from the school district. The clinic appointments will occur on ISD property, however, our health care information will not be shared with the ISD unless/until you give parental permission. The appointments are thru secure tele-conferencing platform and does include physicians in training in addition to the attending Texas Children's Hospital physician.

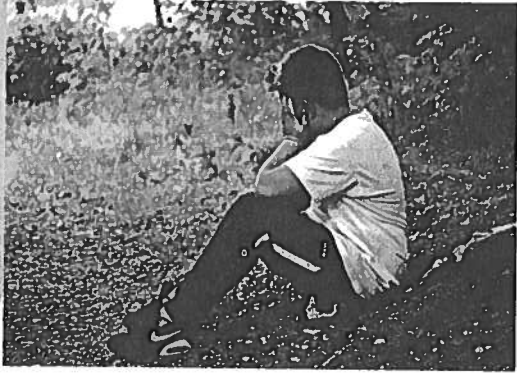
