

## Mauriceville Elementary School Title I Parent Involvement Policy

A goal of the Mauriceville Elementary School Title I program is to encourage greater involvement of parents in the education of their children in partnership with Mauriceville Elementary School staff.

1. During the first six weeks of the school year, a letter will be sent to all parents describing the school wide Title I program of Mauriceville Elementary. All parents will be invited to attend a meeting at Mauriceville Elementary during the first grading period for discussion of the instructional objectives and methods of the program.
2. Partnerships between the home and campus are encouraged at Mauriceville Elementary. Through the Campus Improvement Committee, parents can provide input about the program and parent involvement.
3. Teachers will arrange for conferences with parents concerning their child's progress as needed and at the parent's request. Parents will be invited to observe the Title I program at parent involvement meetings and at Open House. During these meetings, parents will be made aware of the procedures and expectations of the program. There will also be discussion of ways in which parents and the school can work as a team to help children.
4. Professional Development training for the Mauriceville Elementary staff will include training in working effectively with parents and building home-school partnerships.

This commitment to family involvement is aligned with the commitment of Little Cypress-Mauriceville CISD as expressed in the district parent involvement policy that has been approved by the Board of Trustees. The campus Title I staff will coordinate this commitment. The principal will assume leadership and promote cooperation from school staff.
