

THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION
NASHVILLE SCHOOL DISTRICT
OCTOBER 17, 2011

The regular meeting of the Nashville School Board was called to order at 6:00 by President Miles Mitchell. Other members present were, Phillip Turner, Monica Clark, Mark Canaday, and Randy Elliott.

The first order of business was the election of School Board officers. Miles Mitchell made the motion that officers be rotated as has been done in the past. Randy Elliott seconded the motion. The result would be as follows: Phillip Turner – president, Monica Clark – vice president, Mark Canaday – secretary, Randy Elliott – board member, and Miles Mitchell – board member. The motion passed 5-0.

President Phillip Turner then called for the approval of last month's minutes. Miles Mitchell made a motion to approve and Mark Canaday seconded the motion. It passed 5-0.

In old business, Superintendent Doug Graham asked the board to accept a bid from Tri- State Asphalt Inc. of \$59, 290.00 to improve the asphalt parking lot at 6th Street Auditorium. Other bids considered were a concrete bid for 198,000.00 and a bid from Wiley Calhoon for 69,800.00. Monica Clark made a motion to accept the bid. Miles Mitchell seconded the motion and it passed 5-0.

Mr. Graham recommended the payment of the bills. Mark Canaday made a motion to approve and Randy Elliott seconded the motion. It passed 5-0.

Mr. Graham presented a Power Point to review the district's test scores. He reported improvement in 3 out of 4 of the district's campuses. Nashville Junior High did not make AYP according to Mr. Graham and will go to year 2 School Improvement. He stressed that no official announcement would be made until late October, but stated that none of our scores were under appeal.

Mr. Graham asked the board to approve Assurances and ACSIP plans for each building and the district. Miles Mitchell made a motion for the approval and Mark Canaday seconded the motion. It carried 5-0.

Phillip Turner announced the ASBA Regional Meeting at Geneo Central on October 27th. He stated that 4 members would be attending.

Mr. Graham asked the board to approve the employment of Ruth Lively as Primary School custodian. Monica Clark made a motion to approve and Randy Elliot seconded the motion. It passed 5-0.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:30.
