

**REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION  
NASHVILLE SCHOOLS  
November 15, 2010**

The regular meeting of the Board of Education of the Nashville School District was called to order at 6:00 at the Administration Building by President Miles Mitchell.

Phillip Turner made a motion to approve the minutes from the last meeting and the second was made by Monica Clark. The motion passed 5-0.

Doug Graham recommended a contract be entered into with Educators Consulting Services, Inc. ECS will consult at Nashville Elementary in regards to student achievement. The contract was approved for \$50,000.00. ECS will be on site for a minimum of 40 days. Monica Clark made a motion to proceed and Phillip Turner seconded it. The motion passed. 5-0.

A motion was made to approve the paying of the bills by Mark Canaday. Randy Elliott seconded the motion. The motion passed . 5-0.

A presentation was made by Michael and Sara Beth Herron, band and choir directors for NJHS and NHS. The Herrons spoke about the growth of the program and the need for an additional director in the future.

Mr. Graham made a recommendation that the school district purchase 75 Kindles for the high school campus for about \$12,000.00. Phillip Turner made a motion to approve the purchase and it was seconded by Monica Clark. The motion passed. 5-0.

Mr. Graham reported that he had been informed that our high school ALE would no longer receive funding unless we included a credit recovery plan for students. We will write a plan that includes a credit recovery plan this spring.

Mr. Graham announced that Tammy Elliott had been recognized with a national FACS award.

Mr. Graham stated that starting in January, meetings and workshops would begin with board members, community leaders, and parents. The Public Facilities Division has indicated their intentions to participate in some part of the district's future building projects. The legislature will prioritize projects this spring. A millage extension will be required.

Moving on to other business, Mr. Graham recommended the hiring of 2 new employees; Ms. Karen Sullivan at the Primary School Cafeteria; and Ms. Reba Coulter at Nashville Elementary School as second secretary. Phillip Turner made a

**motion to accept Mr. Graham's recommendation. Randy Elliott seconded the motion and it carried. 5-0.**

**As there was no other business, Phillip Turner made a motion to adjourn and Miles Mitchell seconded it. The meeting was adjourned at 6:30.**
