

**REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION
NASHVILLE SCHOOLS
December 16, 2010**

The regular meeting of the Board of Education of the Nashville School District was called to order at 6:00 at the Administration Building by President Miles Mitchell. Board members in attendance were, Mitchell, Randy Elliott, and Phillip Turner.

Phillip Turner made a motion to approve the minutes from the last board meeting. Randy Elliott seconded the motion and it carried 3-0.

In old business, Doug Graham discussed the progress on the High School Kindle project, stating that all 75 Kindles had arrived and preparations were being made to have them in the hands of the students in early 2011

Elementary School Principal, Paul Tollett, presented a quarterly report on School Improvement. Mr. Tollett listed the procedures in place to insure improving test scores.

The Superintendent's report was given by Mr. Graham. He reported that the Qualified School Construction Bonds were available. Mr. Graham had been in conversation with Carey Smith of Stephens, and they would prepare to apply before the February deadline.

Mr. Graham remarked on the amazing number of 1,883 books that were read by the Senior English classes during the 1st semester of school and commended the teachers and students involved.

He also reported on the Jobs Funds. The Nashville School District was notified that they should qualify for \$367,088. Plans would need to be made on how the district would use these funds.

Phillip Turner moved to accept the resignation of Tina Krantz. Randy Elliott seconded the motion. It carried 3-0.

Mr. Graham announced that due to the Martin Luther King Holiday, the next board meeting would be held on Tuesday, January 18, 2011.

The meeting was adjourned and everyone was invited to enjoy refreshments.
