

**THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION
NASHVILLE SCHOOL DISTRICT
MARCH 15, 2012**

The regular meeting of the Nashville School District was called to order at the above date at 4:00. The meeting was called to order by President, Phillip Turner. Other members present were: Monica Clark, Mark Canaday, and Miles Mitchell.

A motion was made by Mark Canaday to approve the minutes from February 21, and Monica Clark seconded. It carried 4-0.

Superintendent Douglas Graham asked the board to approve the payment of bills. Miles Mitchell made a motion to approve and Mark Canaday seconded the motion. It passed 4-0.

Mr. Graham reported on the 2011 School Audit and Corrective Plan. He explained one finding on segregation of duties, stating that Asst. Superintendent Joe Kell would be double-checking some accounting practices. Mr. Graham asked the board to approve the School Audit and Corrective Action Plan. Miles Mitchell made a motion to approve and Monica Clark seconded. It carried 4-0.

Mr. Graham asked the board to consider making Pre-AP English I an honors course. Monica Clark made a motion to approve and Mark Canaday seconded the motion. It was stated that the 9th graders of school year 2012/13 would be the first class affected. After some discussion on the required number of honors courses, the motion carried 4-0.

Mr. Graham then asked the board to consider allowing Comp I and II to count for Senior English. Mark Canaday made a motion to allow Comp I and II to count for Senior English, and Miles Mitchell seconded the motion. It passed 4-0.

Mr. Graham reported on the building process and the continued search for a Head Band Director and Agri. Teacher.

Mr. Graham asked the board to accept the resignations of Head Senior Boys Basketball Coach, Ted Green, and Elementary Classroom teacher, Charlotte Binkley. Miles Mitchell made a motion to accept the resignations and Mark Canaday seconded. It carried 4-0.

The meeting was adjourned at 4:25.
