What Is a Community School?

A community school is a public school that serves TK-8th grade and has community partnerships that support improved academic outcomes, whole-child engagement, and family development. Partnership strategies include integrated support services, extended learning time, and collaborative leadership and practices for educators and administrators.

Community schools use this community-driven shared decision-making approach to increase access to nurses, counselors, and social workers. This creates campuses that are community hubs where students and families have easy access to the services needed to close opportunity gaps.

Standard School District has been fortunate to receive a California Community Schools implementation grant. Our first primary focus is on addressing chronic absenteeism in our schools through a collaborative approach. To achieve this, it is crucial to connect students and families with other partners and agecies to remove barriers to regular school attendance. By working together, we can advocate more effectively for our students and find ways to enhance communication between school district staff and community partners, thereby increasing the number and frequency of services provided.




