

## Basketball Procedures 20-21

The 20-21 Highlander Basketball Season will begin this Friday at 5:30. Obviously a few things have changed due to the situation with Covid. Keep in mind that we are required to follow all AAA, Health Department, and CDC Guidelines to be allowed to have a basketball season, and continue to play games in our facility. Superintendent Pruitt has signed a required agreement with the State Department of Elementary and Secondary Education, Arkansas Activities Association, and the Health Department that requires us to follow all health and safety guidelines such as social distancing, and wearing masks in the facility. Please be advised of the following rules and procedures to help keep everyone safe, and allow us to continue the use of our gym for games. Please review the following guidelines for safe attendance purposes.

- All tickets for the games are sold through [Hometownticketing.com](https://www.hometownticketing.com). We are limiting capacity due to social distancing restrictions to 120 tickets sold. A link to purchase tickets is on the Eureka Springs Homepage. Parents of the team will have first access to purchase tickets before the public. Tickets are \$4, with an additional charge of around \$1.45 per ticket for the use of the electronic ticket service. To ensure your ticket is reserved and to streamline entry, we encourage you to purchase your ticket in advance at [https://www.eureka-springs-schools.k12.ar.us/291909\\_2](https://www.eureka-springs-schools.k12.ar.us/291909_2). If tickets are still available, we will have a device at the gate that you can use to purchase your ticket online.
- Games will be live streamed through Facebook Live on the Eureka Springs School Facebook page for those not able to attend.
- Staff and their immediate family such as spouse and school age through grade 12 get in free. **No need to purchase a ticket.**
- Students get in free. **No need to purchase a ticket.** Students in grades 9-12 will soon have an issued ID card that can be used to get in games. Students in grades K-6 must be accompanied by a parent and remain with the parent to get into and stay at the game. Students are not allowed to run around freely at the games or be unattended.
- AAA passes will be honored. **No need to purchase a ticket.**
- Booster Passes (SOLD OUT) will be honored. **No need to purchase a ticket.**

- Masks are required to be worn the duration of the time spent in the building except while eating and drinking. Face shields are not sufficient. A mask must be worn in addition to a face shield if you choose to wear one.
- Family units are to sit together and social distance from other family units. Students may sit with family, or social distance from others in the student section.
- Fans and students must enter through the main gate at the rear of the building. No one is allowed to enter through the lower gym doors. Once students leave the games they are not allowed to enter the facility again for that evening.
- All AAA sportsmanship guidelines must be followed.

Students and fans not following requirements may be asked to leave the game and could be removed for the remainder of the season.
