- 2. Recipient must be an approved graduate of Norwich High School.
- 3. The scholarship will be for one year only.
- 4. Payment of the award will be made to the student upon presentation to the Milton/Norwich Inter-Church Council of receipt for paid enrollment fee.
- 5. Admission or commitment will be made by the recipient by September 1st of that school year.
- 6. The scholarship must be used for the next ensuing year, except in the case of an emergency, and then only with the approval of the Milton/Norwich Inter-Church Council.
- 7. The Inter-Church Council will award one \$300.00 scholarship each year. The continuation of this scholarship being awarded is at the discretion and financial ability of the Milton/Norwich Inter-Church Council.
