

Eligibility & Criteria for Milton/Norwich Inter-Church Council Scholarship Award

All Norwich High School Seniors are highly encouraged to apply

1. Primary Considerations:

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| a. Leadership | Shall exert and show good leadership qualities in all activities. |
| b. Scholastic | Maintain at least a 2.5 grade point average during their senior year. |
| c. Attitude | Shall display good general attitude to fellow students and school staff. |
| d. Moral Values | Be a good example and show a high degree of maturity as a student. |
| e. Involvement | Be involved in a church and/or youth group; in the case of multiple outstanding applicants, preference will be given to an attendee of an Inter-Church Council church. |

- 2. Recipient must be an approved graduate of Norwich High School.**
- 3. The scholarship will be for one year only.**
- 4. Payment of the award will be made to the student upon presentation to the Milton/Norwich Inter-Church Council of receipt for paid enrollment fee.**
- 5. Admission or commitment will be made by the recipient by September 1st of that school year.**
- 6. The scholarship must be used for the next ensuing year, except in the case of an emergency, and then only with the approval of the Milton/Norwich Inter-Church Council.**
- 7. The Inter-Church Council will award one \$300.00 scholarship each year. The continuation of this scholarship being awarded is at the discretion and financial ability of the Milton/Norwich Inter-Church Council.**
- 8. Any graduating student wishing to be considered for this scholarship must make proper application with the high school counselor by filling out the scholarship application.**
Deadline for this application will be April 1st of the student's senior year.
