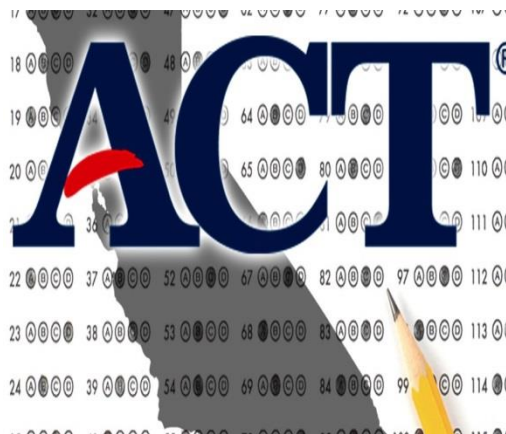
PER CREDIT HOUR

There is a new opportunity available for Juniors to take online college classes at a much reduced rate. Tuttle High School has entered into a partnership with WSU Tech, a community college affiliated with Wichita State University in Wichita, KS. Through their JumpStart program, tuition will be \$72 per credit hour (which is about half the rate at Redlands). And course credits will transfer to most colleges and universities! Sophomores: Begin Planning Now For ACT
