It's time to start your Senior Checklist of things to do and upcoming deadlines. If you will be going to college, the most pressing deadlines are the FAFSA, college applications and scholarships. The sooner you file your FAFSA the sooner you will know what financial aid you qualify for. In the same way, colleges usually award scholarships on a first-come first-served basis. So the sooner you apply, the more scholarship money will be

available. Also lots of colleges require your FAFSA before they will consider you for scholarships. So make sure to check college deadline dates. And there are lots of scholarships with deadlines throughout the year, so begin the scholarship search and application process now. If you want to improve your ACT scores, be sure to sign up and take the test soon. And if you are planning to enlist in the military, begin that process.
