Sophomores: Oklahoma's Promise Final Deadline



If you have not yet completed your application for Oklahoma's Promise (OHLAP), a state sponsored scholarship that pays for college tuition, click the link in the sidebar on page 1. Specific qualification information can be found there as well as the

online application. This year is your last opportunity to qualify for the scholarship. Even if you're unsure whether or not you will go to college, if you meet the qualifications you need to apply. If you decide not to go to college, nothing is lost. However, if you do enroll in college, having this scholarship in place will be a great financial help.
