For High School Seniors in the 2019-2020 academic year.

**IMPORTANT:** A completed application must be submitted to the Southwestern Oklahoma Historical Society with a postmark of **January 15, 2020**. Before preparing this application it is recommended that the instructions provided be read and followed.

The purpose of the Ellenbrook Scholarship is to encourage the knowledge of history in the area of Southwest Oklahoma. It is limited to graduating high school seniors living in southwest Oklahoma. The scholarship is \$500.00, one time tuition award, for the first semester of a college or university in Oklahoma.

The requirements for the scholarship are:

1. High School seniors in southwest Oklahoma, graduating in 2020. Counties in southwest Oklahoma are: Beckham, Caddo, Comanche, Cotton, Grady, Greer, Harmon, Jackson, Jefferson, Kiowa, Stephens, Tillman, and Washita.
2. Applicants must submit a type written research paper of not more than 2500 words, on 8 1/2 by 11 inch pages, with references. Type should be Times New Roman size 12. A title page is required. PAPERS MUST BE POSTMARKED NOT LATER THAN JANUARY 15, 2020. The paper cannot be previously published.
3. The subject of the paper should be about an event, historical site, individual(s), or an action that occurred in Southwestern Oklahoma. Students are encouraged to research and write about such an event or action that occurred in their local community or county. The subject must have occurred BEFORE December 31, 1999.
4. The paper must be reviewed by the student's History and English instructors who will sign the title page of the paper. THIS IS REQUIRED. The instructor's names are required to ensure the paper meets English and Historical requirements.
5. The Southwestern Oklahoma Historical Society is the only judge of the quality and suitability of the papers submitted and their judgments cannot be reviewed or changed other than by the Southwestern Oklahoma Historical Society Scholarship Committee.
6. All papers submitted to the Southwestern Oklahoma Historical Society shall be the property of the Oklahoma Southwestern Historical Society and will belong to the Society.
7. All papers submitted to the Southwestern Oklahoma Historical Society may be included in the journals of the Southwestern Oklahoma Historical Society.
