

Oklahoma High School ACT

OPTIONAL Free ACT Exam Information:

On October 19th, all 10th, 11th, and 12th grade students will have the option to take a free ACT paid for by the OK State Department of Education. The ACT is a college entrance exam and is utilized to measure a high school student's readiness for college. You can find more information about the ACT at *act.org*. Based on what is assessed on the ACT exam, it is advantageous for students to have already taken or be currently enrolled in Algebra I, Algebra II, Geometry, English III, and Biology. While these courses are not required, the content of the exam may be more difficult if your student has not completed these courses.

In addition to the optional ACT, all sophomores are required to take the pre-ACT, which is given in October also. The Pre-ACT assessments are multiple-choice and provide students an early measure of College and Career Readiness while serving as a practice opportunity for the ACT[®] test. If your student is a sophomore and hasn't met the recommended pre-requisites above, you may consider taking just the pre-ACT.

There will be a follow-up meeting for students who have registered once school begins; however, it is very important to submit registration as soon as possible. Registration is due no later than August 18th to your counselor. There will not be any late registrations due to exam ordering deadlines. It is also very important to remember that once registered, your student is required to take the exam on this date.
