

McCamey ISD Filing Period for Trustee Election

The McCamey Independent School District will be holding a school board trustee election on Saturday, May 2, 2020, as well as a Special Election.

McCamey ISD consists of five single member Districts with two At-Large positions to complete the seven member board of trustees.

The positions to be filled this year are District 2 and At Large Position 7. Each of these positions is for a three-year term. Only registered voters who reside within the single member District 2 can vote for the District 2 position and a candidate for the District 2 position must live within the District 2 boundaries to run for the position. An At Large candidate can live anywhere within the district and all registered voters within the school district can vote for this position. Currently the single member District 2 Trustee Position is held by Will Kennedy and At Large Position 7 is held by Crystal Marquez.

A Special Election is to be held for a vacated seat. This position to be filled this year is for District 1. This position is for a one-year term. Only registered voters who reside within the single member District 1 can vote for the District 1 position and a candidate for the District 1 position must live within the District 1 boundaries to run for the position. Currently the single member District 1 Trustee Position is held by Oscar Sanchez.

Application for a place on the ballot may be made at the McCamey ISD Administration Office at 112 East 11th Street, between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. on regular business days beginning Wednesday, January 15th. The filing period ends at 5:00 p.m., Friday, February 14th. The write-in deadline will end on Tuesday, February 18th at 5:00 p.m.
