

KANSAS SCHOOL ATTENDANCE LAW

In compliance of Kansas Statute 72-1113 and 72-1111 as described in Senate Bill, No. 38, schools must report students not in compliance with Kansas Compulsory Attendance Laws. The guidelines state that a student is **NOT IN COMPLIANCE** if any of the following occur:

- The student accumulates **THREE** consecutive unexcused absences.
- The student has **FIVE** unexcused absences in a semester.
- The student has **SEVEN** unexcused absences in a school year.
- The student has accumulated **SEVEN** unexcused tardies.
- The student has excessive, over **SIX** excused absences and does not provide a doctor's note.
