Much of this work is being done electronically. To help you with guidance for the minimum number of minutes your child should be spending online, we have created the following guidelines.

5 th Grade	50 minutes
6 th Grade	60 minutes
7 th Grade	70 minutes
8 th Grade	80 minutes
9 th Grade	90 minutes
10 th Grade	100 minutes
11 th Grade	110 minutes
12 th Grade	120 minutes
