"New" Carl Albert State College Concurrent Admissions Requirements

Admissions Requirements:

1. To admit a student to CASC, the policy will measure the high school senior and junior using the same measurements. Testing tools will be expanded to include SAT, Residual ACT, and PreACT.
2. Juniors and seniors may be admitted to CASC using the same parameters: a minimum high school **GPA of 3.00**, **19 ACT National or Residual or PreACT**, or **900 SAT**.
3. Students may test with ACT Residual one time per year and use those scores for enrollment.
4. Students may use the **PreACT** test (typically taken during the 10th year) for admissions purposes.
5. The Petition for Overload has been eliminated and replaced with a signature permissions found on the Permissions Form.

Course Enrollments:

6. Student are still required to meet the subject test minimum score to enroll into courses in those subject areas (i.e. a 19 English ACT subject test score is required to enroll into English 1113).
7. However, beginning with the fall 2017 term, students whose subject test score falls below the minimum may test with ACCUPLACER and, if successful, be allowed to enroll into their desired course. (i.e. students with an 18 English ACT subject test score may test with ACCUPLACER and may be admitted to English 1113 when the cutoff test score is met or exceeded).

ACCUPLACER:

8. The ACCUPLACER is CASC's on-campus secondary placement exam, offered **free** of charge for the **first testing session**, and **\$5.00 for each testing session thereafter**.
9. **Students should call in advance to confirm or schedule a testing time.**
10. ACCUPLACER tests include English, Mathematics, Reading, and Science with results available immediately upon conclusion of testing. Average testing time is about 30 minutes per test.
11. Unlike the ACT, students may test for one subject as needed. (i.e. i.e. students with an 18 English ACT subject test score may test with ACCUPLACER and may be admitted to English 1113 when the cutoff test score is met or exceeded).

Hopefully, these changes will make concurrent education accessible to more students. I have attached the "New Concurrent Application", the "Returning Concurrent Application, and a handout to help understand the costs associated with concurrent enrollment.
