Virtual Learning Plan

(Grades 7-12)

OVERVIEW & PURPOSE

- The purpose of this guide is to provide answers and expectations for virtual learning.
- We will maintain academic rigor while providing a sense of stability to our students and families.

EXPECTATIONS

- Students are required to complete all school work given by their teachers, whether by Google Classroom, Exact Path, Downloaded Software, Study Island, or Courseware in the time frame assigned by the teacher of record.
- Students will complete assignments daily, or maintain adequate progress.
- Students should expect to spend 6 to 7 hours a day to complete school work. Some students may need additional time.
- Core courses (English, Math, Science, and Social Studies) and Electives will have assignments issued through Google Classroom, Exact Path, Downloaded Software, Study Island or Courseware.

WHAT TOOLS WILL WPS PROVIDE

- Every student will be issued a Chrome Book and Accessories.
- Students will be provided Hot Spots and Campus connectivity to complete Internet /Web based assignments.
- Each student will be provided a login or link to access Google Classroom, Exact Path, Downloaded Software, Study Island, or Courseware.

HOW WILL STUDENTS RECEIVE WORK

- Students (PK - 6) will receive assignments virtually through Google Classroom, Exact Path, Downloaded Software, Study Island, or Courseware. All assignments in Google Classroom or Downloaded Materials are due the following Monday. Assignments in Exact Path, Study Island, and Courseware are graded as they are completed, and progress monitored by the teacher of record. Students will have access to Hot Spots and Campus connectivity to complete Internet /Web based assignments.

HOW TO COMMUNICATE WITH MY CHILD'S TEACHERS

- Teachers will have daily office hours to assist your child and help students with any problems that might arise. Office hours will be held in a virtual platform.
 - Office hours Mon- Friday 8 am – 3:30 pm
- Each core subject area teacher will attempt to make contact with your child at least once a week.
- Communication may include but not limited to: Google classroom, email, text, and phone calls.

HOW TO RETURN WORK

- Students will return work through Google Classroom, Email, Text or completing the Exact Path, Study Island, and Courseware software assignments created by their teacher of record. Students

will have access to Hot Spots and Campus connectivity to download assignments , and return Internet / Web based assignments.

Will Work Be Graded

- Yes, academic expectations and integrity remain in force. In order to receive credit, all assignments created by the teacher must be completed.

MEAL OPTIONS

- Meals will delivered Monday and Wednesday by bus, and available for pick up in the school cafeteria.

SPECIAL EDUCATION

- If your child participates in the Special Education program their Special Education teacher will contact you to make arrangements for support and services.

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
