

Dayton High School 2019 Summer School Information

Summer school will be held at DHS from June 10 to July 3. Students who have failed a course or need to retake an EOC test are eligible to attend. Digital credit courses and EOC review and testing will be offered. Here are the details:

Digital Credit Information

June 10 – July 3	
Initial Credit/Early Grads	7:30-11:30 a.m., room 245
Credit Recovery	12:00-4:00 p.m., room 245

1. Initial credit is available only to early graduates with approval from their counselor.
2. Credit recovery is available to students who did not pass or were denied credit and want to regain credit.
3. The cost per semester credit is \$100.
4. Breakfast will be provided at no cost beginning at 7:00 a.m., in the DHS cafeteria.
5. **Transportation is not provided for credit recovery.**

Student Rules and Expectations

1. Students will abide by the rules of discipline in the Student Handbook and Code of Conduct.

4. Summer school is a concentrated instructional program. Students must arrive on time and be committed to the routine necessary for success.
5. Students will be immediately dismissed from summer school for any of the following offenses.
 - Possession or use of alcohol or drugs
 - Fighting
 - Poor and/or disrespectful behavior
 - Vandalism of any kind
 - Reckless driving
 - Possession or use of tobacco
 - Two or more minor discipline issues
6. Students will remain in their assigned area during summer school.
7. Students must leave campus each day after classes are dismissed.
