

# Expanded Program for 2018/2019 School Year

Program Highlights:

## Tuition-Based Full Day Pre-K

- **All Day Program** from 8:00 am – 3:45 pm Community Hours (6:45 am –4:30 pm) District employee's hours. Students whose parents or grandparents are employed by DISD will qualify for extended hours to meet needs of the district. Students who qualify for our Federally Funded Program will be eligible for reduced rate.
- Program will follow the 2018-2019 DISD Academic Calendar.
- All classes will be taught by **highly qualified teachers** who are certified in Early Childhood Education by the state of Texas.
- Class size will be **limited to 22 students to 2 adults**.
- Open to all children who live within the DISD Zoning Boundaries who will be **4 years old on or before September 1, 2018**. Also, open to children and grandchildren of current DISD employees who have turned **4 years old on or before September 1, 2018**.
- **Child-Centered curriculum focusing on the Texas Pre-K Guidelines** including: Social and Emotional Development, Language and Communication, Emergent Literacy skills in Reading and Writing, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies, Fine Arts, Physical Development and Technology.
- **Formative Assessments and Report Cards** will be given every 6 weeks and checklist and quick checks in between.
- Summative Assessments will be given at the Beginning, Middle, and End of the Year.
- **Cost: \$400.00 per month for 10 months. \$100.00 (non-refundable) application and registration fee is due at time of registration; Students whose parents or grandparents are employed by DISD will qualify for a reduced Rate of \$350.00/month. \$100.00 (non-refundable) application and registration fee is due at time of registration; Federally Funded Qualifying Student Reduced Rate: \$200.00 per month for 10 months. \$50.00 (non-refundable) application and registration fee is due at time of registration.**
- Applications will begin being accepted on April 2<sup>nd</sup> (District Employees) and April 11<sup>th</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup>, and 13<sup>th</sup> at the Colbert Cafeteria for the COLBERT Pre-Registration Pre-K Round-Up from 9 am – 2 pm. After that, they will be accepted at Colbert Elementary from 9 am- 2 pm, Monday – Friday until classes are full.
- Enrollment is limited and applications will be considered in the order in which they are received.
- Bus transportation will be available to those who need it.
