## Indiahoma TSA Goes to State

Indiahoma students attended the 2014 Oklahoma TSA (Technology Student Association) State Conference this year to compete in a wide range of technology competitions. There were a total of 11 students who went: Kameron Belcher, Heaven Pueblo, Esperanza Bosques, Chloe Nevarez, Kaylyn White, Cameron Wozniak, Raven Jackson, Gage Downs, Elizabeth Jones, Colby Duffendack, and Daniel Patton. The students prepared all year for this competition.

Heaven Pueblo and Esperanza Bosques competed in the Medical Technology issues. Chloe Nevarez competed in Vex Robotics along with Kaylyn White and Gage Downs. Kameron Belcher, Raven Jackson and Gage Downs competed in System Control Technology and placed fourth overall in State. Heaven, Esperanza, Chloe, Kaylyn, Cameron, Raven and Gage all competed in the team event of Rube Goldberg. They placed tenth overall in State. Colby Duffendack and Elizabeth Jones competed at the high school level Technology Problem Solving. Danielle Patton competed in Prepared Presentation and placed second overall in State, qualifying to attend the National Conference in Washington D.C. She also placed second in Essays on Technology and qualified to attend Nationals in this competition as well.

This is the sixth year in a row that an Indiahoma student has qualified to attend the National Conference and the third year for Danielle Patton. The students did an outstanding job in all of their chosen competitions. We are proud of them and have high hopes for the National Conference this summer.
