## Rally at the Capitol for Education!

A delegation from Indiahoma Schools attended the “Rally at the Capitol” held Monday, March 30th. They were among the estimated 7,000 teachers, school staff, students, & parents who made the trip to let lawmakers know what’s on their mind: the education of Oklahoma children. The over-reaching idea is to impress lawmakers to make education a priority in the budget and policy. This year high-stakes testing and teacher pay were emphasized. Opponents to amount of testing say that the tests eat up too much time and money while not delivering enough benefits. Many would like to see the various tests given to high school students replaced with the ACT, which is used as a college entrance requirement.

Teacher pay was the other order of business at the rally. Oklahoma is in the bottom three states for teacher pay. Many believe that the salary average in Oklahoma contributes heavily to the teacher shortage the state is facing.

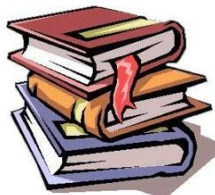


## \$500.00 Grant Recieved
