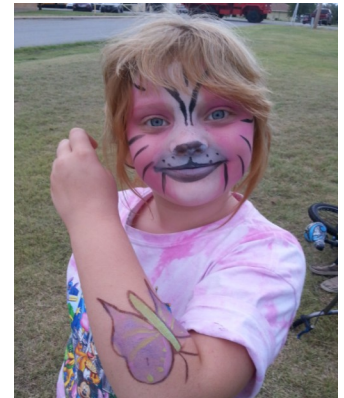
Nita Whitman graduated from Cameron University in Lawton. Ms. Whitman, being unsure of
