Greenhouse Open for Business



Students in the fourth through sixth grade are testing their green thumbs as they plant plugs in the school greenhouse. The students are participants in the after school program. They are being taught a little horticulture by Indiahoma agriculture teacher Brian Sapp, Lawton Ag teacher Lindsey Hoerbert and retired ag teacher Jay Woodward. Other adults from the school and community are helping with the project.

For the last two weeks, students have learned how to plant a plug, from creating a hole in the soil to stimulating the spreading of roots, to packing the soil around the young plant. Each week the students will observe the progress of their plants. High school agriculture students are assisting by watering and labeling the plant containers. This makes the project a school-wide effort.



Some plants will go to beautifying the campus flower beds while the majority will be sold later in the spring.
