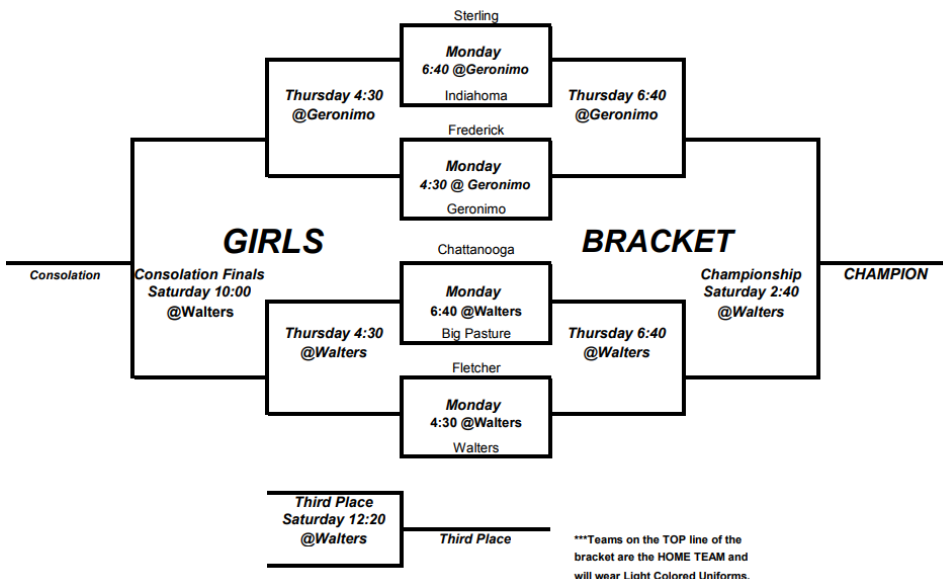

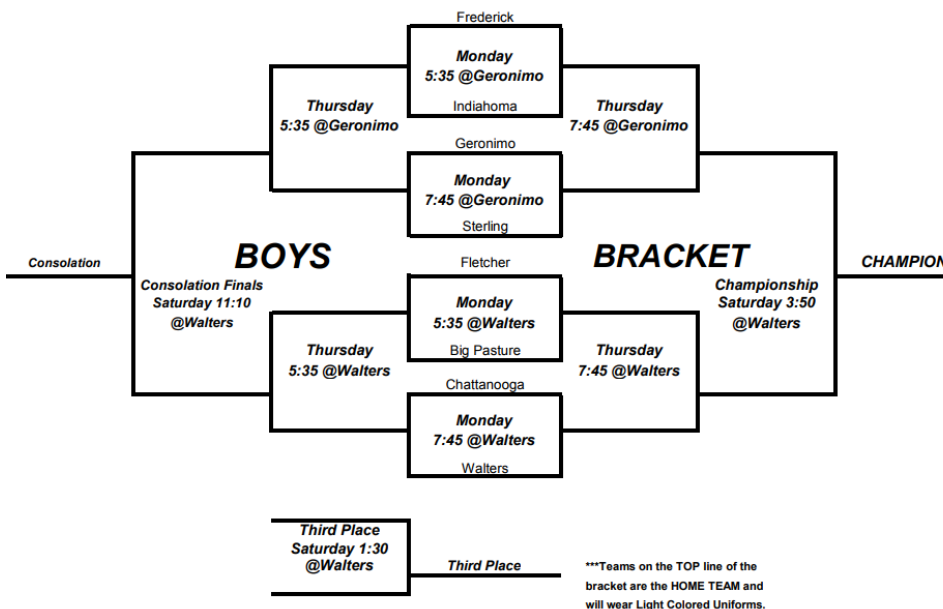

Fifth Grade Starts Ft. Sill STARBASE Program

DoD STARBASE focuses on elementary students, primarily fifth graders. The goal is to motivate them to explore Science, Technology, Engineering and Math (STEM) as they continue their education.

The program engages students through the inquiry-based curriculum with its "hands-on, mind-on" experiential activities. They study Newton's Laws and Bernoulli's principle; explore nanotechnology, navigation and mapping. They are captivated by engineering as they use the computer as a design tool. Math is embedded throughout the curriculum and students use metric measurement, estimation, calculation geometry and data analysis to solve questions.
