Indiahoma Boys Crowned Best of the Southwest Tournament Champions

Indiahoma took their #13 Class B State ranking and 7-2 record into the Best of the Southwest Basketball Tournament and exited with a 10-2 record and Championship trophy. Indy downed round 1 opponent Granite 57-45, second round competition Hollis by a count of 44-22 and in the championship game they eked out a victory over Carnegie by a score of 53-51. Senior Dyllan Plaster came up big over the three-game stretch with a total of 68 points (22.6 per game) and an All-Tournament nod, while junior Tdohasan Sunray averaged 13 points, 7 rebounds, 5 steals, 2.5 assists and 1.5 blocks per game on way to receiving the Tournament MVP designation. Numerous other Warriors were important contributors to the tournament run with Antonio Reyna dominating on the boards after returning from a broken ankle, Nick Chibitty controlling the offensive tempo and making key defensive stops, Quintin Watson, Trace Thomason and JJ McClung providing needed and timely offensive scoring and Timothy Martinez contributed the defensive punch early on. The Indiahoma girls pulled off one win during the tournament against Granite, with Katelyn Kimble leading all scorers with 24 points in the game. Mackayla Chibitty led all scorers with 10 points in the team's tournament game one loss to Hollis.
