The Indiahoma High School boys basketball team has advanced its record to 3-1 on the season with a 32 point win (75-43) on the road at Cement after a tough home loss to Duke by a count of 64-47. Over the two-game stretch, senior Dyllan Plaster and junior Tdohasan Sunray continued to pace Indiahoma in scoring with 35 and 33 points respectively. Senior Trace Thomason found his range at Cement, hitting five three pointers and finishing with 17. After posting 13 points in the Duke contest, junior Antonio Reyna broke his foot early during the Cement game and will be out of service for an undetermined time. The Indiahoma girls have had a difficult start to the season (0-4), but head coach Brooke Roberts has seen progress with her girls as they enter their Homecoming game on Friday. The junior high boys are off to a 3-3 start to the season with Joesyah Johnson leading the team with 63 points and Kowi Sunray chipping in 45 during the six-game stretch. The junior high girls only game so far this season resulted in an away loss to Cement.
