Give Blood—Give the Gift of Life

Blood Facts:

- B** Donated blood has a short shelf life—42 days for red blood cells. This is why the blood supply needs to be replenished constantly.
- B** On any given day, an average of 38,000 units of red blood cells are needed.
- B** Fewer than 5% of healthy adults eligible to donate blood actually donate each year.
- B** Volunteer donors provide nearly all the blood used for transfusions in the U.S.
- B** Anyone in good health, 17 years of age or older who weighs at least 110 pounds may donate blood every 56 days.
- B** Blood is the fluid that circulates in a person's heart, arteries, capillaries and veins carrying nourishment and oxygen to and taking waste from all parts of the body.
- B** About 8% of a person's weight is blood. The amount of blood varies according to height and weight, but an average man has about 12 pints of blood; an average woman has about 9 pints.
- B** White blood cells protect the body against infection and disease, fight bacteria and help the body to develop immunity to disease.
