**Clinical Pharmacist**

Justin Lambert is an Indianhoma High School graduate who will be the presenter at the January Senior Citizens Luncheon. Justin is a clinical pharmacist at the Oklahoma Department of Veteran Affairs specializing in geriatric care. If there is enough response, he would like to come back in February and/or March to sit down with people individually and review their medications making sure that they are the appropriate medication and dose, review side effects, drug interactions and effectiveness of treatment among other things. Justin is very excited about providing this service and hopes it will grow much bigger and be beneficial to the people in Indianhoma.

### **Treasure Lake Job Corps Helps Indianhoma Service Projects**

Indianhoma Service Learning class received toys and food from the Treasure Lake Job Corps Student Government Association. The SGA had a toy drive/food drive and wanted to donate the toys and food to our service learning class for distribution as a way of saying “Thank You” for giving the Job Corps kids a place to stay when they were evacuated during the fires. Mrs. Evelyn Carter-Sawyer, the SGA sponsor, delivered the toys and food with four student government students and Katherine Hunt (Job Corps employee and Indianhoma resident).

146 cans of food were given to the FFA food drive. The toys were divided between the Angel Tree project and Service Learning Class’s back packs for kids in crisis at J Roy Dunning Children’s Shelter. The FFA and individual students helped the service learning class purchase the final items for the backpacks so they can be delivered by Christmas. (Each backpack contains a blanket, a stuffed toy, coloring book, crayons, a reading book and, thanks to Job Corps, a couple of extra little toys.) It feels like Christmas when we all work together to help other people.
