The American Academy of Pediatrics Back-to-School Tips

Walking to School

Make sure your child's walk to a school is a safe route with well-trained adult crossing guards at every intersection.

Be realistic about your child's pedestrian skills. Small children are impulsive and less cautious around traffic, so carefully consider whether or not your child is ready to walk to school without adult supervision.

Bright colored clothing will make your child more visible to drivers.

Biking to School

Always wear a bicycle helmet, no matter how short or long the ride.

Ride in the same direction as auto traffic.

Use appropriate hand signals.

Respect traffic lights and stop signs.

Wear bright color clothing to increase visibility.

The Ten Commandments of School Bus Safety

1. Thou shalt honor thy bus driver and do what he or she says. The bus driver is the boss on the bus.
2. Thou shalt use good manners and be polite.
3. Thou shalt remain seated while the bus is moving.
4. Thou shalt not scream, yell, shout or be loud. This could distract the bus driver and cause an accident.
5. Thou shalt not throw things.
6. Thou shalt not eat or drink on the bus.
7. Thou shalt not leave trash on the bus.
8. Thou shalt keep thy hands to thyself. (Don't hit, pinch or bother other people.)
9. Thou shalt take good care of the bus so it will stay in good condition.
10. Thou shalt remember that riding the bus is a privilege, not a right.

Student Directory Information Release Notification

According to Oklahoma School Law and OSSAB Policy FLD, The Indianhoma Public School District will maintain and release 'directory information' without the parent's prior written consent, **unless the parent- or student if over 18 – informs the district** that any or all of the following information should not be released without prior consent.

The following information is designated as 'directory information'.

- Student's name, address, telephone listing, and date and place of birth;
- Parent or lawful custodian's name, address, and telephone listing
- Major field of study and grade level classification (example: elementary, 7th grade, sophomore);
- Student's participation in officially recognized activities and sports;
- Weight and height of members of athletic teams;
- Photograph;
- Electronic mail address;
- Dates of attendance, dates of enrollment, withdrawal, re-entry;
- Diplomas, certificates, awards, and honors received;
- Most recent previous education agency or institution attended by the student
