## Preparing for Grades 4 & 5 CBTs

The Oklahoma State Department of Education (OSDE) Office of Assessments is committed to helping districts effectively plan for the administration of Grades 4 and 5 computer-based tests including: Chromebooks, laptops, iPads and desktop computers. The tests are designed to be administered on the computer and feature a variety of universal tools that are more engaging and aligned with 21st century teaching and learning practices. The testing calendar has been extended an additional week to provide schools more flexibility administering computer-based testing. In addition, the following tools have been developed to prepare students, educators and technology coordinators:

1. The OSTP Grades 4 & 5 Readiness Tool provides educators and students access to test-drive the iTester platform.

## Oklahoma History Field Trip to Ft. Sill

On Friday, Sept. 28th Mrs. Boss' Oklahoma History class and the HS academic team took a field trip to Ft. Sill for a living history exhibit. The group traveled between eight stations, encountering history re-enactors and interpreters at each station.

They learned about the buffalo soldiers from a retired Army Sergeant Major .He spoke of an officer whose first assignment was Ft. Sill. This officer had tried to oust General Patton's aid to take the job himself in a gutsy confrontation.

This officer's writings to his wife and detail accounts of the early days of the fort are kept in the archives on post.



Students witnessed a real cannon shot from a four-man team. They learned the responsibilities of each man on the team and how they worked together .

One of the stations hit close to home as students were introduced to life at school for children in the late 1800's. Those children walked to and from school, sometimes several miles in harsh weather as school was in session in the summer and winter, reserving spring and fall for planting and harvesting. Besides classes, students had to chop and haul wood for the classroom stove. Lunch was cold and out of a bucket.

The season opener saw the Warriors at El Dorado for the El Dorado-Olustee tournament. Both teams fell to Duke in the first round, but much experience was gained as many students saw action in these games.
