

The Lovington Wildcats kicked off the 2019 golf season last week. We competed in Ruidoso on Thursday March 21, in Roswell on Friday March 22 and in Artesia yesterday April 1.

Both the boys and girls team took second place in Ruidoso. Katheryn Campbell was the Girls Individual Medalist. Rial Williams took second place on the boys side.

On Friday in Roswell the Girls took first place beating Artesia by four strokes. 344 to 348. Kathryn lead the team with a 75. Isleen Ontiveros shot an 80, Brianna Tarin shot a 92, Melissa Sanchez shot a 97 and Katelynn Ramirez shot a 100.

The boys also took first place in Roswell with a team score of 311. Tres Arreola Lead the boys with a 72, which was also good for Individual Medalist, he was followed by Rial Williams with a 73, Ashton Aranda shot an 82, Austin Costello shot an 84, and Jered Jeffery 88.

Yesterday in Artesia both the Boys and Girls won the Tournament. The boys won by 30 strokes with a score of 303 beating the next closest team Artesia. We love beating Artesia. Tres Arreola lead the boys with an even par score of 72, which was also good enough for Medalist again. After just three tournaments both the Boys and Girls have qualified for the state tournament. We are very excited by this start and are working hard to continue to improve our play in hopes of bringing home not one, but two, State Titles.
