

USE OF SCHOOL BUS FOR NONSCHOOL AND EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Extra-Curricular Activities

This school district's transportation may be used for field trips, extra-curricular activities or school-sponsored activities. The superintendent may authorize the use of private vehicles when necessary.

Nonschool Activities

The school may furnish district transportation for students to attend nonschool activities such as state or county fairs, summer youth programs, community programs, or science and math programs held at college or university sites. The superintendent must approve such trips.

Adults may ride school buses when they are designated as chaperones for the students on the bus at that time.

Transportation Requests

When participating in a school activity, which requires school transportation, the sponsor should submit a transportation request to the principal at least two weeks prior to the trip. In the event that a conflict cannot be resolved, the administration will determine the priority. Date of request is not a determining factor in such decisions.
