

## **SCHOOL VISITORS**

The board of education believes that parent involvement is one of the ingredients of a successful school. Parents are welcome to visit the school; however, they are encouraged to stop by the office before visiting a classroom. Granting permission to visit a classroom in session will be at the option of the school administrator.

Students are not allowed to bring other children as visitors to the classroom.

The superintendent or principal shall have the authority to order any person out of the school building and off school property when it appears that the presence of such person is a threat to the peaceful conduct of school business and school classes. Any person refusing to leave should be reported to an appropriate peace officer in that he/she may be guilty of a misdemeanor, punishable by fine or imprisonment.
