REGULATION GRADING, REPORTS TO PARENTS AND STUDENTS

GRADING SYSTEM

Grades 7 - 12 will use the following grading scale:

AP Classes, Pre-Engineering, OSSM, Concurrent Classes and classes approved by principal will use the following grading scale (this grading scale will go into effect July 1, 2015):

87-100 =	A=	4 Grade Points
77-86=	B=	3 Grade Points
67-76=	C=	2 Grade Points
57-66=	D=	1 Grade Point
56 – 0=	F=	0 Grade Point

All other classes in grades 7 - 12 will use the following grading scale:

90-100=	A=	4 Grade Points
80-89=	B=	3 Grade Points
70-79=	C=	2 Grade Points
60-69=	D=	1 Grade Point
59-0 =	F=	0 Grade Points

REPORTS TO STUDENTS AND PARENTS

Student's grades can be accessed by parents through the school's web-based gradebook program. The link for this gradebook program can be found on our school district web site. On a weekly basis, parents are notified via an automated notification system of ineligible students. This automated notification system is also used on a daily basis to notify parents of attendance issues. Report cards are issued each nine weeks. Progress reports will be sent at the middle of each nine-week period. If there are questions or concerns about a student's grades, the parent or guardian should communicate with the respective teacher and/or principal. Discipline notices will be mailed as needed. Reported acts of unsatisfactory citizenship will be addressed through the disciplinary program.
