

## CLOSED CAMPUS

Chandler Junior/Senior High has a policy of “Closed Campus”. Students are not allowed to leave the campus during school hours, unless accompanied by a parent, for any reason other than emergencies or urgent business (medical appointments, etc.). Once the student has arrived at the school site, he or she must remain until school is dismissed at the end of the school day unless properly excused by the principal. Requests to leave campus must be made by a parent or guardian.

Student will be excused for one of two reasons:

1. A student may leave the school grounds with his or her parent or guardian provided that the parent has personally checked the student out through the principal’s office. This is discouraged except for an emergency or urgent family business.
2. Student who have appointments with a local doctor, dentist, etc. Appointments must be cleared before leaving campus.

Students will not be permitted to make curbside visits with people in passing cars, on motorcycles, etc.

Students are not permitted to leave campus for lunch unless they are picked up at the school by a parent or guardian. A permit to leave must be obtained before leaving campus.

School grounds will be closed to all persons who are not officially enrolled at the school. Visitors are not permitted on campus without the principal’s permission. Parents should come to the principal’s office immediately upon arriving on campus.

Students will report directly to the school grounds upon arrival by bus, car, or foot. There will be no loitering near school grounds prior to morning arrival.

A student who leaves campus without permission will be placed in In-School Supervision on the first offense and will be suspended from school on the second offense. Vo-Tech students who arrive by bus will not be permitted to leave campus.

**Basic Rule: Once on campus, stay on campus.**

## PERMITS TO LEAVE CAMPUS

Requests for permits to leave campus must be made by a parent or guardian and must be made in advance of the absence.

Students who have more than ten absences will not be issued permits to leave campus.

Requests to leave campus to attend a school activity or function in which the student is not directly involved will not be granted unless arrangements have been made one day prior to the event.
