Dear Parent/Guardian/Staff/Visitors:

The Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) was enacted in 1986 to determine the extent of and develop solutions for any problem schools may have with asbestos. Healdton schools have had our facilities inspected by accredited asbestos inspectors as required AHERA. Additionally all periodic surveillances and inspections required by AHERA are being made and incorporated into the management plan for each facility. Each six months surveillance and three year re-inspection at our schools is conducted by Dan Tracy, an AHERA inspector and management planner OKMP-137706.

We will continue implementing the asbestos management plans in our facilities. Our intent is to comply with all applicable federal, state, and local regulations relating to AHERA. The Healdton Public School system is committed to maintaining a safe and healthy environment for all children, employees, and guests in our school.
